This method promotes active learning, as students are able to draw conclusions based on the evidence they encounter. For example, when teaching present continuous tense, the teacher may provide a series of sentences where the tense is used, and students will analyze these examples to infer the rules governing its usage [Chalipa, 2013].

While these two approaches are often discussed in isolation, it's important to note that in practice, many language instructors combine both methods to suit the

needs of their learners. The choice of approach is influenced by the learner's age, proficiency level, the nature of the grammar topic, and the learning environment.
